We offer a wide range of #1 size bare root perennials. These plants are field grown for one year to make them the perfect size for producing a one gallon pot. All of our plants come packed in quantities of 25 unless otherwise stated. This allows you to purchase several different varieties without producing far too many plants overall. Our large color labels are packed to match the count of the plant.

Tubers, Corms and Bulbs

We offer a large selection of tubers, corms and bulbs especially suited for pot production. Popular items such as Dahlias, Lilies, Crocosmia and Callas, for example all make excellent plants for pots. 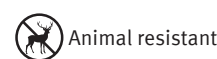

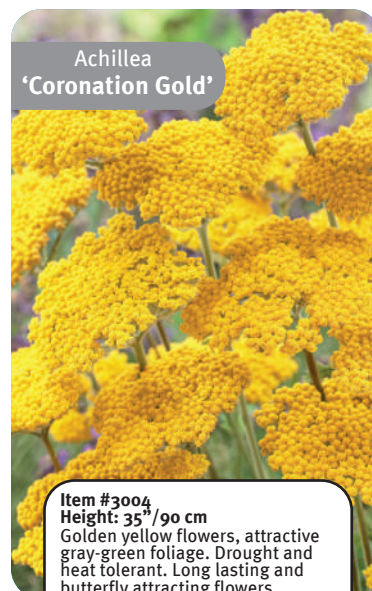

ACHILLEA

ACHILLEA *Yarrow*

The flower heads are flat, compound corymbs and the main flowering period is early spring until mid summer. The plants tolerate poor, slightly acidic soils but do need well-drained soil. The flowers of most varieties make excellent fresh or dried flowers but pollen must be visible before the flowers are cut, otherwise vase life will be reduced.

Butterfly Weed

The stems are topped by many small umbels of many small flowers in spring and continue to bloom for at least six weeks in the garden. Plants prefer a well-drained soil and are very tolerant of poor dry conditions and drought. Asclepias can also be used for cut flowers and are excellent for large landscape projects. Butterflies are attracted to the plant because of its color and nectar production.

japonica: Early flowering glossy green foliage tinted with red. Blooms are produced in tight triangular clusters.
simplicifolia: Glossy lobed leaves. Grows little bit slower than other types.
