### **Daffodil Thalia**

With its pure white flowers, the Daffodil Thalia is something different. Daffodil Thalia is one of the few daffodils that open out pure white. Buy wholesale daffodil bulbs at De Vroomen. The fragrant white flowers, like snowflakes, look absolutely terrific in a field of grass. Daffodil Thalia grows three to four flowers per stem. Each flower, sometimes with two or three heads at one stem, has a straight trumpet with slightly arched petals. The leaves are thinner than leaves of common daffodils, like the Dutch Master. But this doesn't mean these daffodils don't deserve a place in the yard. The Daffodil Thalia is the perfect small-garden daffodil.

### **How to grow Daffodil Thalia**

It's not too difficult to grow a carpet full of white daffodils, like daffodil Thalia. Although the flowers may look fragile, they are tough enough to stand elegantly, even in the worst spring squalls. How to grow Daffodil Thalia?

- Plant the bulbs in Fall or Winter
- Plant Daffodil Thalia in cool, rich soil
- The bulbs love a sunny (or half sunny) spot
- Plant the bulbs 5-6" (12-15 cm) deep
- Keep about 4" (10 cm) distance between the bulbs
- Plant daffodil Thalia's in small groups for better visual impact

### **How does Daffodil Thalia look**

Daffodils are winter-hardy plants, this means they can survive a frosty winter. Daffodil Thalia's start blooming from March/April and grow up to 14" (35 cm). Despite the fact the flower looks terrific, we should also name the lovely scent of this daffodil. The sweetly scented flowers smell like white blossoms and dance in the wind. These daffodils can handle a windy day. Daffodil Thalia's naturalize easily and are also suitable for flower pots and containers.
