Peony Paul M. Wild

Paul M. Wild produces large-flowered dark ruby-red, fuchsia, purple bright flowers. This midseason peony has superb colors that show the same color throughout the whole flowering period. The velvety flowers are fully double and resist fading. The dark green foliage makes this Peony one of the favorites reds. At De Vroomen, you order bare-root peonies to plant in the garden, backyard, or border.

About the Peony Paul M. Wild

The Peony Paul M. Wild is one of the many Red peonies that are grown in Holland. These Dutch peonies are high-qualified and produce exclusive flower heads. The beautiful double Peony Paul M. Wild makes the perfect border plant, as the flowers bloom on sturdy erect stems. The flowers reach a height of 2-3 feet (60-90 cm). This midseason, early-summer perennial shows its face from May to June and is lightly-fragrant. The plant is deciduous and will lose its leaves and petals in winter.

Care for the Peony Paul M. Wild

- Plant the Peony Paul M. Wild in fall, from September to October
- Choose a clay, loam or sandy ground
- Mix the soil from the plant hole with organic compost
- Keep the soil moist, but well-drained
- Make sure the soil has a neutral pH-value
- The plant takes about 2-5 years to establish and flower
