### **Peony Shirley Temple**

The truly fascinating Peony Shirley Temple shows beautiful light pink blossoms from late spring to early summer. This midseason peony handles bad weather and will flower approximately for 7 to 10 days. If left undisturbed in winter, the Peony comes back every year. Plant the Peony Shirley Temple in well-drained soil. At De Vroomen, we sell bulk bare-root peonies for bulk prices.

### **About the Peony Shirley Temple**

- The Peony Shirley Temple:
- Must be planted in fall, from September to October
- Must be planted in well-drained soil on a sunny place
- Grows up to 32-36"; (80-90 cm) high
- Blooms later than many other peonies
- Starts flowering from June to July

### **Care for Peony Shirley Temple**

The Peony Shirley Temple shows glamorous, pale blushy white-pinkish flowers. Peonies know a short flowering period, but the flowers grow heavy and large. The rose-shaped Peony has a heart of small, loosely arranged ruffled petals. The Peony Shirley Temple thrives in the full sun or partial shade. Deadhead the flower heads after flowering, around September. Cut back the stems around 2"; (5 cm) above the ground. Add organic compost or fertilizers in early spring.
